**DOG LICENSES:** All dog licenses expired December 31<sup>st</sup>. The licensing fee for each dog is \$12. Penalties for an unlicensed dog start at \$100. Please come into City Hall anytime between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m. and get your dog ready for the New Year!

**OVERNIGHT PARKING:** No parking is allowed on city streets from December 1<sup>st</sup> through March 1<sup>st</sup>, between the hours of 12 midnight and 7 a.m. **NO MOTORIZED VEHICLES, INCLUDING FOUR-WHEELERS OR SNOWMOBILES, ARE ALLOWED IN CITY PARKS VEHICLES IN VIOLATION WILL BE CITED.**

**SNOW REMOVAL:** The city council has directed the city employees to do their best to remove the snow berm created by the snowplow and grader (no intent to clear driveways). They are concerned about damaging property in the process. We cannot assume liability for any damage that occurs.
