STORAGE OF UNUSED VEHICLES: It is a violation of city code to keep “abandoned, inoperable, discarded or unused” motor vehicles on your property longer than fourteen days, unless enclosed in a building. The city

requests that residences remove or enclose such vehicles. We call your attention to the fact that Pacific Recycling (529-4180) will remove old vehicles for free and pay owners up to \$200 for scrap metal. (Ordinance 166 – City code section 3-2.)

FALL CLEANUP: Fall cleanup starts October 10. We live in a windy city, so grass clippings and leaves should be bagged in sturdy bags. They are near impossible to haul otherwise. Please remove all vehicles and trailers from the alleys and have everything out by the 10th because it is difficult and expensive to backtrack. Thanks for your cooperation. Tires, paint and chemicals, batteries, used oil, or large pieces of concrete will not be picked up. We will start on the southwest corner of town and move east, and then start on the north side of town on the west and move east.
