OVERNIGHT PARKING:

Beginning March 1st, our snow ordinance is no longer in effect until December 1st. We would appreciate your continued cooperation in not parking on the streets when we have a snowstorm. We would like to remind those out shoveling their sidewalks and driveways to not shovel the snow into the streets because once the plows have gone by it becomes a hazard on the street and often packs

down and becomes difficult to remove. We recommend finding a good spot on your property to pile the excess snow.
