**Spring Cleanup:** The city has set a date of **May 9th** to start spring cleanup. **Please wait for city wide clean-up to put out garbage to help prevent the wind from blowing garbage around our city. To help those of you that would like to start your clean-up early, the dumpster on the west side of**

**town just north of the old elevator will be available for use on April 1<sup>st</sup>. Please do not use the dumpster for household garbage.** Since it is expensive for the crews to backtrack, we will be unable to accommodate backtrack requests. Due to regulations, please be reminded first, we cannot pick up leaves and grass clippings unless they are bagged. Second, we cannot pick up large projects such as remodeling materials, roofing, large pieces of concrete, tires, paint, chemicals, batteries, and used oil. Please cut tree limbs to ten-foot lengths or less. Please remove all vehicles and trailers from the alleys and have everything ready for pickup by **May 9th**.

**Arbor Day Celebration:** As Sugar City is an official Tree City, USA, the Tree and Beautification Committee will be holding an Arbor Day Celebration on **May 9th, 2016 at 11 a.m.** near the gazebo in Heritage Park where a new tree will be planted.
