

MINUTES OF SPECIAL MEETING
SUGAR CITY COUNCIL
MONDAY, JUNE 27, 2011

Presiding: Mayor Glenn W. Dalling
Meeting Convened 6:30 a.m.

Present: Mayor Dalling; Sharon L. Bell, Clerk; Councilmembers Bruce King, Lamont Merrill and Vaun Waddell; Public Works Director Zane Baler; and Burch Drake. Councilmember Harold Harris was excused.

Mayor Dalling reported that the reason for calling this special meeting is that Councilmember Merrill expressed concern about one of the decisions made at city council on Thursday, June 23, 2011, and he would like to have it changed. Also, regarding park sign locations, they failed to discuss the matter with Public Works Director Zane Baler on how the locations relate to the sprinkler systems. The mayor requested that Councilmember Merrill make a motion to rescind the motion he made on June 23.

MOTION TO RESCIND MOTION MADE JUNE 23, 2011: It was moved by Councilmember Merrill and seconded by Councilmember Waddell to rescind the motion made at our last city council meeting with regard to the placement of the sign in Heritage Park and opt for a different location; motion carried.

RELOCATION OF THE PARK SIGNS: Public Works Director Zane Baler addressed the council.

Neibaur Park sign: Rather than putting the sign down in the center of the park, Zane suggested moving it to the southeast corner, where it would be easy to relocate the sprinklers.

Heritage Park sign: Zane suggested moving the sign down to the northwest corner, where it would be easy to relocate the sprinklers.

Lyle H. Moon Park sign: Zane suggested moving the sign a little to the south and a little to the east about 6 to 8 feet. It is close to where it will be okay.

Smith Park sign: Zane suggested that the sign be moved to the southwest corner above the retaining wall so everyone can see it. At that location, it will not affect snow removal. They will not have to remove any fences or sprinklers. The sign will face north and south.

MOTION FOR RELOCATION OF THE PARK SIGNS: It was moved by Councilmember Waddell and seconded by Councilmember Merrill to locate the park signs with the Heritage Park sign in the northwest corner, the Neibaur Park sign in the southeast corner, the Lyle H. Moon Park sign adjusted southward for sprinklers, and the Smith Park sign in the southwest corner outside the fence under the guy wires; motion carried.

MESSAGES ON PARK SIGNS: The council was presented with a handout containing the wording suggested by Councilmember Waddell and Burch Drake for the park signs. Each sign contains, first, the name of the park, and, second, a short message.

MOTION: It was moved by Councilmember Merrill and seconded by Councilmember

Waddell to accept the naming of the parks as outlined on the sheet verbatim as presented; motion carried.
