

**The City of Sugar City, Idaho**

**Resolution No.: 2017 - 17**

**“A Resolution to Adopt a Fee Structure for All Animals, Including Dogs, as Authorized in Chapter 4-1-13 and 4-1-14; and Chapter 4-4-10 of the Sugar City Code.”**

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Sugar City, Idaho desires to adopt new fees by resolution as authorized in Chapter 4-1-13, 4-1-14, and 4-4-10 in the Sugar City Code, for infraction penalties on all animals, including dogs; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUGAR CITY, AS FOLLOWS:

Chapter 4-1-4: Annual Dog License Fee: The annual license fee is \$15.00 for each dog (prorated if new dog to household for less than a year).

Chapter 4-1-5: Replacement of Dog Tag: Replacement of a tag is \$5.00 for each tag lost.

Chapter 4-1-6 and 4-4-7: Impoundment of All Animals: Impound fee is \$100, plus \$5 a day for boarding. For a dog that is licensed, the fee will go to \$50 for the first offense, plus \$5 a day for boarding, and then the regular fee for any further offense.

Chapter 4-1-6 (d): Disposal of Dogs: If owner is known, then owner will be billed the actual costs of disposal of dog, plus three (3) days care at \$5/day, plus 20% of that total for labor of city employees.

All Other Animal Violations: Infractions of Chapter 1 and Chapter 4 of Title 4 of the City Code shall be assessed a penalty of \$100. If the infraction continues, each day's violation shall be a separate offense. Misdemeanors shall be prosecuted in the Magistrate's Court of the Seventh Judicial District of the State of Idaho, in and for Madison County, with penalties not to exceed the limits set forth in section 1-4-1 of the City Code.


